



Kindergarten checklist

Let's get ready for kindergarten

Enrollment

Each student enrolls once when entering the district. Enrollment is a two-step process.

Step 1 - The first step of the enrollment is completed online at www.lakeviewspartans.org. Assistance and computers are available at Central Office. **Step 2** - To complete the enrollment process, certain documentation is required. Please see the Kindergarten Enrollment Process handout in the kindergarten welcome folder for complete details on the enrollment process.

Registration

Students register each year at the building they attend. Kindergarten parents will receive information on registering their child once the enrollment process has been completed.

Immunizations

Incoming kindergarten students must be up-to-date on their immunizations to start school. A list of required immunizations for school entry is available in the kindergarten welcome packet.

Vision & Hearing Screenings

All incoming kindergarten students are required to have a vision screening prior to the start of school. Hearing screenings are also recommended. Free vision and hearing screenings for all incoming kindergarten students will be available on the dates below. Please call to schedule an appointment time.

Any student entering kindergarten at Lakeview, regardless of which elementary he/she will attend can make an appointment.
