### **FREE Meals Available for Students**

Families may continue to pick-up food under the Governor's *Stay Home, Stay Safe* order. Our sites will serve meals Monday-Friday, including the week of Spring Break, at the following times and locations:

- 11 am-12 noon - Lakeview Middle School circle drive
- 12 noon-1 pm - Prairieview and Riverside Elementary parking lots
- 1 pm-2 pm - Minges Brook parking lot

### **Online Learning and Instructional Support**

Below is the basic information you will receive. *Please note, there will be no assigned work or office hours during Spring Break, April 6-10.*

#### **Grades 7-12**

- Teachers will have an office hour every day for parents or students to contact them virtually
- Teachers will provide weekly online work (*no work will be counted for a grade, but it is highly recommended to keep student education moving forward*)

#### **Grades K-6**

- Teachers will have an office hour every day for parents or students to contact them virtually
- Teachers will provide weekly math and English work/activities (*no work will be counted for a grade, but it is highly recommended to keep student education moving forward*)
- Special/Elective teachers will provide resources for enrichment
