

Bronson Battle Creek Volunteers
Memorial Fund Scholarship

The Bronson Battle Creek (BBC) Memorial Scholarship Program is funded by generous donations to the BBC Volunteers Memorial Fund. The purpose of these scholarships is to provide financial assistance to high school seniors planning a career in a human healthcare field.

Five Scholarships will be awarded this year. Three will be given by the Bronson Battle Creek Volunteers.

An additional scholarship has been established by the Lawrence family. Mike Lawrence, an active volunteer President this year, made this scholarship possible.

The Mary Lightbody Scholarship has been donated by her family in her memory. A nurse herself; a nurse educator; former President of the Battle Creek Health System Volunteers and active member; Mary is remembered for her timeless dedication to the scholarship committee and commitment to the Battle Creek Volunteers mission.

Eligible applicants will:

- Be graduating seniors who plan to pursue a career in the human health care field
- Have attained a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better;
- Have an ACT score of 22 or above;
- Be a senior in a high school in the Calhoun Intermediate School District (CISD) or be a home-schooled student in the CISD service area.
- Provide up to date High School and College transcripts

Applications will be available in the counselor's office of all CISD high schools.

The monetary awards will be sent directly to the school of choice of each award winner.

One member of the BBC Volunteers Scholarship Committee will be designated responsible for receiving the applications and preparing them so they can be evaluated anonymously. That member shall not have a vote in selecting the winning applicant. The remaining members of the BBC Volunteers Scholarship Committee will serve as the selection committee.

Selection of the scholarship winner will be based on academic achievement, evidence of good citizenship, leadership, and writing skills, which will demonstrate a desire to pursue a degree in a human healthcare field. Selection of the scholarship winner will be independent of financial need.
