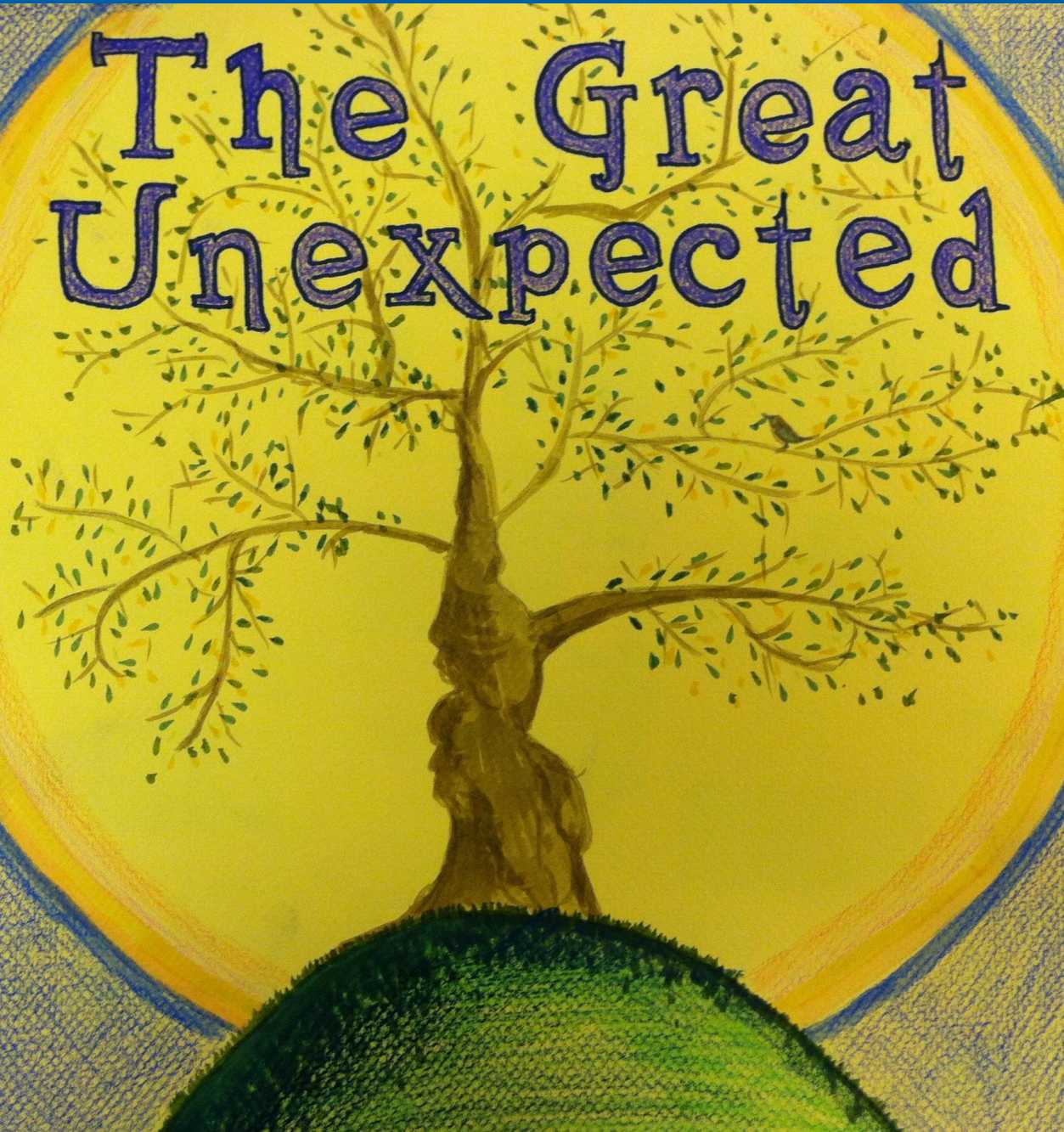


The Great Unexpected
